Dear Mr. Wang:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated May 11th, 2006 that arrived in our offices yesterday, May 25th, 2006. We did not receive an electronic copy to the best of my knowledge. This explains the reason for the response dated May 26th, 2006.

However, your Canadian agent, Hylton Karon has informed us of your concerns that the Feather Bra was infringing your client's patent and that you would be writing to us.

Our trademark lawyers, after studying the patents have given us an opinion that "In overview, in our opinion, it is arguable whether the Feather Bra as presently constructed infringes any claim of Canadian patent 2,359,555."

In spite of this opinion, we have removed the product from our website and have asked that the product be taken off air.

This was a test promotion. Interwood had taken delivery of 300 sets pairs. Sales as of now have been 82 orders. This leaves us with an inventory of 200+ pairs. We are negotiating a return of these goods to our supplier.

We do not see the need for any further action.
